DAN Diving Emergency Management Preparedness



DAN DEMP - 8 hours

This DAN Program combines the DAN Oxygen First Aid, DAN Advanced Oxygen First Aid, DAN First Aid for Hazardous Marine Life and DAN AED for Divers courses into an integrated dive emergency management program. The skills that are common to each of the four courses are only covered one time, which means you can complete this course in one-third the amount of time it would take to complete them separately. You will be able to handle diving emergencies in the unlikely event that they occur to a dive buddy.

Most of the knowledge development for the course is done at home in your spare time using the DAN student manual. During the course we will review that material and answer any questions that you have in a brief discussion session and then spend the rest of the time in actual hands-on scenarios in which you will provide first aid to your "injured" class members. .

Prerequisites

- You will need to have a current first aid and CPR completion card (last 24 months). If you need to refresh your First Aid/CPR skills, I have the Emergency First Response Program available as a separate course that can be scheduled at your leisure. The course is open to divers and non-divers alike.
