DAN First Aid for Hazardous Marine Life Injuries



DAN First Aid for Hazardous Marine Life Injuries - 3 hours

This entry-level course is designed to educate the general diving public to identify hazardous marine life, to recognize possible marine life injuries and provide appropriate first aid (disabling stinging cells, bandaging techniques and pressure-immobilization techniques). Also included is information on avoiding marine life injuries.

Most of the knowledge development for the course is done at home in your spare time using the DAN student manual. During the course we will review that material and answer any questions that you have in a brief discussion session and then spend the rest of the time in actual hands-on scenarios in which you will provide first aid to your "injured" class members.

Prerequisites

- It is recommended that you have a current first aid and CPR completion card. This is not required, however. The course is open to divers and non-divers alike.
